

Playing Store

Objective:

To learn and practice skills in counting money.

Supplies:

- *Price Tags* printout
- *Money* printout (on cardstock)
- scissors
- glue
- plastic zipper bags



Instructions:

Teachers/Parents:

1. Print and cut out price tags.
2. Print 2 pages of money for each student. Have students cut out money and glue like coins or dollars back to back. When glue is dry, store money in separate plastic zipper bags.
3. Choose about 8 - 12 small items from around the house (toys, snacks, school supplies, etc.).
4. Arrange the items on a table and place a price tag next to each one.
5. Play “cashier” as each student “shops” with their respective bags of money.

Students:

1. Count how much money you have.
2. Choose the items that you want to buy.
3. Take them to the cashier and count out your money to pay for the items.
4. Make sure you have enough money for your purchases.

Hints:

- For beginners, use only coins and allow to purchase only one item at a time.
- Take turns being shoppers and cashiers.
- Teach cashiers how to properly make change and count it back.
- Prices do not need to reflect actual prices.
